La Porte de Namur : brewery Le Trappiste or Taverne Toison d'Or. Admire the Saint-Boniface area and its Art Nouveau houses while trying a cold beer at the Ultime Atome. In front of that, Eat&Love (trendy cuisine) and the Belgo belge. In the middle of the chaussée de Wavre: "Beermania" with more than 400 beers. Chaussée d'Ixelles: stop at the house of Bériot. On the left, temple of gastronomy based on beer, le Volle Gas. Other genre, Imagin'Air Art Café. L'Amour fou, extremely cool. End of the tour : Flagey, impressive multicultural "flagship " of the 21st century. Nearby, Le Lantin, the first philosophical café-theatre in Brussels and Le Fourquet, Art Deco brewery from the 60s. Last but not least, the highly prized Belga, on the ground floor of Flagey.

Next to the Bourse, le Falstaff. On the other side Cirio welcomes you.

La Bécasse, l'Imaige Notre Dame and the Bon Vieux Temps come right out of a time machine ! La Rose blanche will tickle your taste buds. Meeting in la Brouette, in the Roy d'Espagne or at the brewers of the Grand'Place.

Folklore at Toone Theatre! At the Saint-Hubert galleries, visit Bruxelles en Scène, the Taverne du Passage or the Mokafe. At the end of the gallery: the Mort Subite. Without forgetting the Delirium Café.

Near the Grand-Place, the Place de la Vieille Halle aux Bl s symbolically marks this tour : this square is the home base of the International Foundation Jacques Brel.

Next, meeting at the Saint-Jacques neighbourhood with its heteroclite atmosphere. Here you'll find the famous Manneken pis and walls decorated with comic book fragments.

Diversity is the best word to describe the public of the Saint-G ry area, historical cradle of the city. Meeting point of the capital's youth.

In the rue Dansaert, young stylists set the trend. Hip restaurants, shops and jewellers complete this magical scenery.

Don't forget to explore Brussel's ancient port with the Sainte-Catherine church.

Back in the rue Dansaert, visit the Jij  Museum and its brewery.

The Belle-Vue brewery will end your tour.

Would you like to go back centuries and travel to foreign parts - in the space of a few yards? Then Saint-Gilles is definitely the place to be for you!

The Porte de Hal is rather like a feudal castle whose stark outline stands proudly against the sky. A little further you might like to take a pleasant stroll down rue Jean Volders. In the shadow of the church: in the Verschueren Brewery trendy young people and more sedate habitués enjoy a beer. Also the Brasserie de l'Union offers a variegated picture of Brussels' life and characters. Other strong points: the roundabout of the Barrière of Saint Gilles and its fountain. The town hall in Renaissance style. The Brasserie de la Renaissance. Moeder Lambic, an absolute must for beer lovers... 250 beers, including numerous draught beers.
